**Course Description:** This course is an introduction to World Wide Web and the Internet, emphasizing methodology of authoring web pages. Hypertext Markup Language (HTML) and (Java Applets) are used for the creations of web pages. The course includes configuration of web browsers to support multimedia applications. Web programming languages are examined. This course is a comprehensive introduction to Web page creation and presentation graphics, using combination of lecture and lab sessions. Students learn how to use File Transfer Protocol (FTP), Adobe Acrobat, PaintShopPro and search engines.



To make this year in Web Page Design and Development the most productive and enjoyable it can be, I have developed a few simple guidelines. Following these will help you to be an active learner and an asset to the class environment.

1.	<b>Be on time to class.</b>	Be seated at your computer and ready to work by the time the bell rings. Lateness will not be tolerated.
2.	<b>Be prepared for class.</b>	You should have a pen, View binder and folder with you daily. If you miss a class, you are responsible for finding out what work you missed and then making it up by the due date.
